### **1. Worthing Symphony Society – All – information**

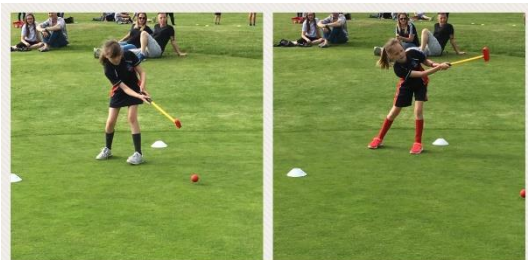

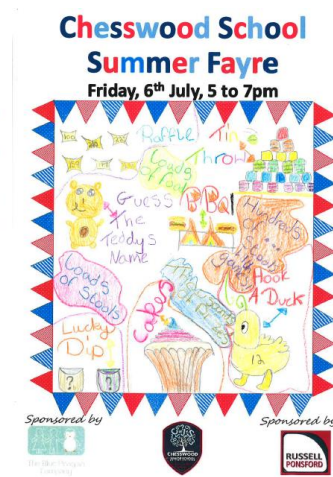
